



LETTER TO RESIDENTS IN THE CENTER TRIANGLE
APPROXIMATELY 500 RESIDENCES

Dear Shelter Island Resident:

The Water Advisory Committee (WAC) has been exploring the feasibility of a municipal water system. We have met with the Suffolk County Water Authority to discuss the scope and estimated costs of such a system in the center of the Island where many wells have unhealthy levels of Nitrogen.

Our next steps in this exploration will involve the residents who live within the area previously identified as at risk. On the map below is a red triangle which illustrates the area of concern:



The next steps in this exploration are:

1. Completing and mailing in the enclosed water test response card
2. Water testing completed for those residents who responded that they would like to have their water tested
3. A public meeting to discuss the outcome of the testing combined with any previous data

This will form the basis of a discussion concerning the need for public water and the desire for such a system among the affected residents. At no time will your property be specifically identified; the discussion will take place by talking about sections, not specific addresses.

Thank you for your attention to this important matter and we look forward to hearing from you.
